Mr. Hudson left the phone number for Mayor Ward to call. Mayor Ward called Sean with ABC legal office and explained that it was a city ordinance. Sean said Mr. Hudson did not tell him there was a city ordinance. The Aldermen agreed to notify by a certified notice/letter to Mr. Hudson/Hudson's Liquor Store that he is not complying with the city ordinance and include a copy of the ordinances.


Other business discuss may be discussed as necessary

Mayor Ward announced the Riley R. Bridge will be closed beginning Monday January 20, 2025 until the new bridge is completed.


Mayor Ward stated the Sewer Rehab is going well.
